Blood pressure (BP): is an indication of the effectiveness of the cardiac output. Measure the patient's blood pressure as soon as possible; low blood pressure (relative to the normal blood pressure of the patient) is often a late sign in the deteriorating patient and can be an adverse clinical sign (Mallet 2013).; Gauge the patient's peripheral skin temperature by feeling their hands to ...

### The ABCDE and SAMPLE History Approach

A final subcategory of adverse event is the ameliorable adverse event, a term first coined in a study of postdischarge of adverse events. Ameliorable adverse events are those that are not preventable, but the severity of the injury \*could have been substantially reduced if different actions or procedures had been performed or followed.\*

### Adverse Events, Near Misses, and Errors | PSNet

Can result in the need for a renal transplant. Type D ADRs (delayed) Can lead to cancers years after exposure to agents. Prime example is asbestos, which can cause cancer in the chest cavity (mesothelioma) decades after first (or even only) exposure to abbestos. Another possible outcome is infertility.

An adverse event is harm that occurs while a patient is taking a drug, irrespective of whether the drug is suspected to be the cause. A side-effect is any effect caused by a drug other than the intended therapeutic effect, whether beneficial, neutral or harmful.
