Many older drivers are able to self-determine if they should drive based on their mental and physical ability. There is no age at which driving privileges are revoked, however if you are 75 or older, you have to renew your drivers license in person at an RMV Service Center to take an eye test. You can also present a vision screening certificate rather than take an eye test.

Under age 21, the license expires 90 days after the 21st birthday. Age 21 and over may renew a valid Driver's License up to six months prior to the expiration date. If the license is expired for more than one (1) year, a vision and written test will be required.

(1) An intermediate license authorizes the holder to drive a motor vehicle under the conditions specified in this section. An applicant for an intermediate license must be at least sixteen years of age and: (a) Have possessed a valid instruction permit for a period of not less than six months;
