Infant chest compressions are performed with 2 (the middle and index) fingers. Compress on the sternum just below the nipple line. The ratio of compressions is 30 for every 2 puffs (breaths). Count out loud as you deliver the compressions.

Red Cross CPR Steps. 1. Push hard, push fast. Place your hands, one on top of the other, in the middle of the chest. Use your body weight to help you administer compressions that are at least 2 inches deep and delivered at a rate of at least 100 compressions per minute. 2.

CPR is a technique involving heart and lungs that is used when breathing stops. Administering CPR can restore breathing and restart the heart if heart failure accompanies the loss of breathing. This valuable technique should be learned by all caregivers and parents in case an emergency arises where professional help is not immediately available.

Here are some key points to Child CPR in case you missed them! □ The same first 3 steps apply for children as adults when giving CPR. (check for consciousness, call for help, open airway check for signs of life) □ After opening the airway, give 5 rescue breaths □ Check for signs of life □ If there are no signs of life, follow with 30 chest compressions with only one hand. □ Continue 30 to 2 ratio until EMT arrives.
