Beginning with therapeutic sedation/analgesic, the patient's care providers promote a natural sleep cycle, enhance the care environment, continuously assess the patient's comfort, implement protocols including daily awakening trials, and evaluate therapy and adjust as needed.

Sedation. ICU Sedation 2009. 12. RASS is a 10-point scale, with four levels of anxiety or agitation (+1 to +4 [combative]), one level to denote a calm and alert state (0), and 5 levels of sedation (-1 to -5) culminating in unarousable (-5).

## **NICE Critical Care**

Sedatives are used in intensive care unit (ICU) to improve patient comfort, decrease anxiety, permit mechanical ventilation and help facilitate interventions. Sedatives may include benzodiazepines, short- or long acting opioids, alpha-agonists (eg. clonidine, dexmedetomidine) and propofol.

## **Sedation hold | North West London Critical Care Network**

The 2013 guidelines (2) suggested targeting light levels of sedation or using daily awakening trials (44 50–52), and minimizing benzodiazepines (53), to improve short-term outcomes (e.g., duration of mechanical ventilation and ICU LOS).

Sedation is important in the ICU to facilitate amnesia during critical illness, to prevent delirious patients from causing harm to self and others, to facilitate invasive management, to promote ventilator-patient synchrony, to circumvent post-traumatic stress disorder and to relieve dyspnea.
