Federal Grant Guidelines

The Federal Grant and Cooperative Agreement Act, passed in 1977, set out to guide government agencies in their use of Federal funds – particularly by defining the roles of contracts, cooperative agreements, and grants.

Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards (2 CFR – 200) – Final revised rule streamlining grant management requirements. This guidance supersedes requirements from OMB Circulars A-21, A-87, A-110, and A-122 (which have been placed in OMB guidances); Circulars A-89, A-102, and A-133; and the guidance in Circular A-50 on Single Audit Act follow-up.

The Office of Management and Budget's (OMB) Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for Federal Awards (commonly called "Uniform Guidance") was officially implemented in December 2014 by the Council on Financial Assistance Reform (COFAR - now dissolved). The Uniform Guidance – a "government-wide framework for grants management" – is an authoritative set of rules and requirements for Federal awards that synthesizes and supersedes guidance from earlier ...

Grants made under the JAG program require a 10% cash match (non-federal) of total line-item costs. Federal grant funds cover 90% of the project costs. The following points should be noted regarding the non-federal match:

Starting in December 2013, the White House Office of Management & Budget unveiled new rules, titled Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, & Audit Requirements of Federal Awards, or Uniform Grant Guidance for short, that streamlined the administration and strengthened the oversight of federal grants. These rules took effect December 26, 2014, and over the course of this year, nonprofits have adopted them as they receive new federal grants or replenishments of existing grants.

If mileage is to be paid, provide the number of miles and the cost per mile. If travel is by air, provide the estimated cost of airfare. If per diem/lodging is to be paid, indicate the number of days and amount of daily per diem, as well as the number of nights and estimated cost of lodging.

Budget Preparation Guidelines

Federal law requires that all Sub-Recipients who receive an Arts Council grant that was paid with federal funds complete an OMB Circular A-133 Audit Form to determine if the organization received \$750,000 or more in federal funds from all sources during the fiscal year in which the grant was awarded (July 1 to June 30).
