Remove the trim shroud. Remove the electrical connector from the key warning switch. Turn the lock cylinder to the RUNposition. Place a 1/8in. (3mm) diameter pin or small drift punch in the hole located at 4 o'clock and 11/4in. (31.75mm) from the outer edge of the lock cylinder housing.
