Harley Davidson engine numbers are generally located on the lower right or left side of the engine casing in the middle. The numbers are usually in a dot matrix format. See below images as a general guide to the number locations but this is dependent on model and year. VIN Location. Engine No Location.

Harley-Davidson motorcycle Frame numbers and VIN Locations

Vehicle Identification Number (V.I.N.) is located on the engine crankcase and is the same as the number located on frame steering head. Example: 1A 13478 H7

From 1930 to 1962 the VIN number was the engine number and was only located on the left case. The VIN was between 8 and 10 digits with the first 2 digits being the production year, the next 2 - 4 letters being the model designation and the last 4 digits being the production number. Example: Year. Model.

The location of the vehicle identification number on a Harley-Davidson depends on the model year, according to Harley-Performance.com. Prior to 1969, Harley-Davidson used the engine number as the VIN, which was located on the left side of the engine. Between 1970 and 1980, Harley-Davidson started stamping the VIN on the frame and also the engines, with the exception of some motorcycles produced in 1979.

Where Can You Find the VIN on a Harley-Davidson?

Engine number is the VIN and is located on the left case. NO frame number. (Generally speaking, I have gotten word that some during 1965-69 did have frame numbers, as well as a different number sequence stamped on the fork crown and transmission case.

Read Online Harley Davidson Engine Number Location

1960s and Older Engines. Look on left side of the engine case for the engine number. Harley engines that were made before or in the 1960s have the model year of the engine as the first two numbers of the engine number, which acts as a VIN. Look for a four-digit production code in the last four digits of the VIN.

Different numbers are stamped in different locations on your Harley Davidson motorcycle. The Vehicle Identification Number is on the swingarm frame and on the crankcase. Numbers are also stamped on the cylinder. Some might think this is the parts number, but the three-part number stands for the casting number.

Locating the Harley VIN Prior to 1961 On Harley models prior to 1961, the engine number acts as the VIN. This number can be found on the left side engine case. Harley models produced prior to 1969 do not carry any frame number.
