Long-term abuse can damage the brain, liver and kidneys; Repeated use of leaded petrol can cause lead poisoning; Have people died from taking solvents? Yes. Sniffing gases, glues, or aerosols kills about 50 people a year. In 60% of deaths from VSA, there is no known history of solvent abuse.
