Between 1892 and 1894 British yards produced more than four-fifths of the world's commercial tonnage. Many of these ships were built at the Thames Ironworks and Shipbuilding Company Ltd at Blackwall. Its origins lay back in 1837 in the form of Ditchburn and Mare founded by shipwright Thomas Ditchburn and naval architect Charles Mare in Deptford but moving north of the river in 1838 and expanding rapidly, building small iron paddle steamers, among the first to do so in the area.

It was Saturday 29 June 1895 when an article was published in the company newspaper for the Thames Ironworks and Shipbuilding Company, the huge shipyard and iron works that had straddled the mouth of Bow Creek at its confluence with the River Thames since 1837.
