Universal pre-K refers to state government-funded preschool programs (meaning free to those who attend it). 1 It also refers to the movement by early childhood education experts and advocates who want to make preschool available to every child in the United States. 2. Ideally, universal pre-K programs should be made accessible to any child in a given state, regardless of their abilities or their family's income status.

“Universal pre-k allows children of all socioeconomic and racial backgrounds the opportunity to attend well-designed, high-quality preschool,” says teacher and Zivadream education advocate Debbie Lopez. This means children who may otherwise have been at a disadvantage—such as those learning English as a second language or those from lower-income households—can receive the same kindergarten readiness as other students.

The legislation for the Voluntary Pre-K (VPK) for Tennessee Act of 2005 was passed by both the House and the Senate in May of 2005. Preschool For All (PFA)

Universal pre-kindergarten allows all children the chance to acquire these skills and provides parents with the means to enroll their children in preschool regardless of their financial situation. Because a universal program is implemented through school districts, children who attend this type of preschool will be able to interact and form friendships with their neighborhood peers at an early age .

One of the best local government programs has been implemented in New York City. Universal preschool was a keystone promise of Mayor Bill de Blasio's 2013 campaign; to his credit, there has been great progress toward fulfilling it. New York City now enrolls more students in pre-K than ever before: in 2019, about 70,000 across the five boroughs. It's open to both 3- and 4-year-olds, unlike many programs, which are limited to 4-year-olds.
