To search for a string in a set of files that you specify with wildcards, you can use this command within a for command. If you use /c and /n in the same command line, this command displays a count of the lines that don't contain the specified string. If you specify /c and /n in the same command line, find ignores /n.

Mapping a network drive to a shared folder from Windows' graphic interface isn't hard. But if you already know the network path for the shared folder, you can map drives a lot quicker using the Command Prompt. Mapping a drive to a network share assigns that share a drive letter so that it's easier to work with.

How to Map Network Drives From the Command Prompt in Windows

On computers running Microsoft Windows 2000 or Windows NT 4.0, the maximum length of the string that you can use at the command prompt is 2047 characters. This limitation applies to the command line, individual environment variables (such as the PATH variable) that are inherited by other processes, and all environment variable expansions.

Command prompt (Cmd, exe) command-line string limitation

Open Command Prompt from Windows+X Power Users Menu. Press Windows+X to open the Power Users menu, and then click "Command Prompt" or "Command Prompt (Admin)". Note: If you see PowerShell instead of Command Prompt on the Power Users menu, that's a switch that came about with the Creators Update for Windows 10.

Findstr is a built-in tool of the Windows operating system that you may run from the command line to find text in files or in command line outputs. You can use the application to filter command line outputs, search individual files or entire directory structures for files with matching text.
